Next half term Year 11 will begin to work on their college applications. They will start with writing their personal statements in PDC lessons. Please research multiple colleges and attend open days. Check college websites, as some require you to book in advance for the open days.

PS16 Timeline

- ⇒ **September to January** 1 to 1 Careers Advise appointment with Lee Flanagan.
- ⇒ October and November Visit College Open Days and attend Lunchtime Talks.
- ⇒ **23rd October to 10th November** Personal Statement writing, PS16 Login Issued Complete profile section and start to add courses to favourites.
- ⇒ Applications need to be completed by **Christmas** to give time for checking.
- ⇒ **10th January** Predicted Grades will be uploaded for you course choices will then be checked against your predicted grades.
- ⇒ **12th January** Final application deadline for students. Tutor references are completed.
- ⇒ School will review and send off all applications to college providers by **31st January.**
- ⇒ **February to April** Post-16 College Interviews take place.
- ⇒ March to May Colleges make offers to students. Students accept or decline the offer.


Parents and Carers - We Need You!

T-Levels are new 2 year qualifications that have been designed with employers to give young people a head start towards the careers they want.
